Minutes of the Meeting of the Parish Council held at St Andrews Mission on 6th February 2017.

17/017 Public Session:-

Cliffe Playing Field Association (CPFA)

Brian Whittaker and Trevor Allan advised that in addition to the £9,500 spent from CPFA funds they had been able to secure a further £41,000 in grants to complete the drainage work in November 2016 and make improvements to the play area.

The group also spoke about their aims for 2017 including further upgrading to the new play area, a joint project with Cliffe Primary School to explore and collate the history of Oxen Lane/ Playing Field land & the links between the field and local schools and a major upgrade of the Playing Field frontage and entrances.

The Chairman congratulated the CPFA on all their hard work and achievements so far.

A member of the public present spoke about the ongoing issue of dog fouling and requested additional dog bins on York Road and between Oxen Lane and Beech Tree Farm. It was agreed that additional dog bins would be considered as part of the Village Plan.

17/018 Listen to reports from County and District Councillors:-

County Councillor M Jordan spoke about the County Councils proposed budget increase for 2017/2018.

A member of the public raised concern regarding the state of Oxen Lane and Councillor Jordan agreed to raise this with Highways.

17/019 Police Report:-

A report listing the recent Ringmaster notifications received by the clerk was distributed.

17/020 Confirmation of Minutes:-

The Minutes of the Meeting held on Wednesday 4th January 2017 were proposed by Councillor M Whattam, seconded by Councillor C Topping and unanimously agreed.

17/022 Items for Discussion:-

a) Receive update on progress of Village Green Project

It was unanimously agreed that Councillor M Topping would buy some trees for the village green which will hopefully be planted in March.

b) Village Plan

The Parish Council spoke about the differences and benefits of both the Village Plan and Village Design Statement.

County Councillor M Jordan suggested a meeting with Selby District Council in the first instance to obtain as much information as possible and this was unanimously agreed.

c) Public Rights of Way

Councillor A Wilson advised that an informal meeting was being held at the New Inn on Sunday 12th February to discuss putting together some walking routes.

d) Highway Issues

NYCC proposal to make an order under the road traffic regulation act 1984 for waiting prohibited at all times with exemptions at Main Street and Hull Road

The clerk reported that she had spoken to Victoria Day (NYCC Project Engineer) who confirmed that NYCC have consulted with all the affected properties and that the proposals have been advertised in the local newspapers with no objections received so the work will be going ahead in April 2017.

Councillor D McSherry spoke about forming a committee to look into a 20mph speed limit but as no committee could be formed this was not taken any further.

County Councillor M Jordan spoke about the 20's Plenty Campaign which encourages residents to voluntarily slow down to 20mph throughout the village. It was agreed that the Parish Council would sign up to the campaign and purchase 100 wheelie bin stickers to remind people of the voluntary limit.

e) Grass Cutting 2017

It was noted that the clerk was awaiting receipt of tenders and it was agreed that this would be discussed and agreed at the March meeting.
