

Police Monthly Police Report – September 2020

Barlby

On 5th September 2020, a male was arrested on suspicion of drug driving on Howden Road. Enquiries remain ongoing in relation to this incident.

On the 7th September, damage was caused to the roof of a building on Carr Lane which had been set on fire.

On 19th September, police received a report of a burglary on Maple Tree Avenue where a car was stolen overnight after the keys had been taken from inside the property. Also on the same night, an attempted burglary occurred nearby on Cherry Tree Walk where suspects have attempted to force entry into the rear door of the house.

Throughout this month, the police have had numerous calls to reports of anti-social behaviour in the recently upgraded play park near Barlby Primary School. It has been disappointing to see that some of the new equipment has already been damaged along with an increase in litter along with lots of reports of older youths shouting and swearing and not sharing the equipment with the younger children.

We are doing regular patrols and checks in the park to ensure that people are behaving as they should, however we would also request that parents also speak to their children and encourage them to behave appropriately and use the equipment fairly when in the park.

Finally, on the 29th September we executed a drugs warrant on a series of flats on Barlby Road, which led to numerous offences being made for drug related offences.

Osgodby

On 24th September, police received reports of door to door sellers on South Duffield Road, officers did attend the area but did not locate the persons.

Cliffe

On 3rd September 2020, a report was received of a garage having been broken into on William Jacques Drive at around 2330hrs. This is believed to be linked to some suspicious males having been seen on The Shrubberies a short while earlier. Enquiries into this matter are still ongoing.

Also this month, on 20th September, 3 cannabis plants were seized from an address in the village and the person responsible interviewed and dealt with accordingly as a result.

South Duffield

There were no incidents of note to report this month.

Hemingbrough

On 24th September, police attended a report of suspicious males on Hagg Lane, on arrival the persons were found to be messing around with a plastic BB gun. The weapon was seized and appropriate action taken.
