18/060 Mary Waud Charity Report (Cliffe School Charity):-

The clerk read out the following report provided by Councillor H Cross:-

Activities: - Makes discretionary grants towards further education to former pupils of Cliffe VC School.

In the year to 31st August 2017, total income was £2,154. Expenditure was recorded at £2,772 including £300 in grant awards and £2,170 in direct payments to the school, these being the cost of transport for swimming sessions (£420) and educational visits (£1,750).

18/061 Cliffe Charity Trust Report:-

The clerk read out the following report provided by Councillor H Cross:-

Cliffe Relief in Need Charity

Activities: - to provide and support with financial assistance those people who live in the Cliffe parish who are in need; either by local knowledge, requests for assistance or the elderly in general.

Cliffe Parish Charity

Activities: - To assist and offer financial support to village organisations who provide facilities that encourage a cohesive, enjoyable and enhanced village life.

The combined income of the charities was recorded at £1,962.

Cliffe Relief in Need Charity donated £25 to each of 24 recipients.

Cliffe Parish Charity donated £150 each to the Cliffe Village Institute and Cliffe Playing Fields, plus £50 to the newly formed Cliffe Brownie Unit.
